# FURNITURE COVERS



It's only natural to want to protect your OHMM outdoor furniture at certain times of the year.

At OHMM we have developed an outdoor cover solution using a high tech fabric from the USA - WeatherMAX<sup>®</sup>. Delivering exceptional durability, water repellency, UV-resistant (i.e. won't fade) with outstanding breathability and mildew resistance, the covers are light weight and easy to pack too.

WeatherMAX® fabric is not waterproof, but highly water repellent and breathable. Being breathable means it will help reduce dampness, heat build up and condensation, thus helping to prevent mould and mildew from forming on your furniture and cushions during storage.

It will withstand light showers but not sustained heavy downpours. Any accumulated water must be removed by gently raising one side of the cover.

OHMM covers feature a hem around the base fitted with marine elastic cord and cord locks for securing them in place. The hem stops 5cm from the ground to allow air circulation to prevent moisture build up inside.

And there is a 5 year warranty against loss of fabric strength or colour loss.

## FURNITURE COVERS

### INSTRUCTIONS

Each cover is made to fit the corresponding OHMM furniture element perfectly and engineered with coloured piping seams to guide you in the right orientation when fitting on to your furniture.

Make sure your OHMM furniture and cushions are thoroughly dry before using OHMM outdoor covers.

The covers are designed to perform for short periods of time and not permanent covers as moisture may build up on the cushions and cause mould and mildew, particularly in humid climates.

The fabric is not waterproof, but highly water repellent. With exceptionally heavy rain for a duration, water may pool and then penetrate the fabric. To drain off any water which may have pooled on top of the covers, simply lift one side to let the water run off.

If storage is needed for long periods, it is recommended to remove the covers from time to time and allow the cushions to air.

### CLEANING

Clean covers with a soft cloth and warm water, using a gentle upholstery cleaner if necessary. Rinse with clear water. Solvents are not suitable for cleaning the covers and may cause damage and discoloration to their surface.

Never pack or fold covers that are wet; instead, let them dry in a well ventilated area.

Hand wash only. Do not bleach or iron the covers.
